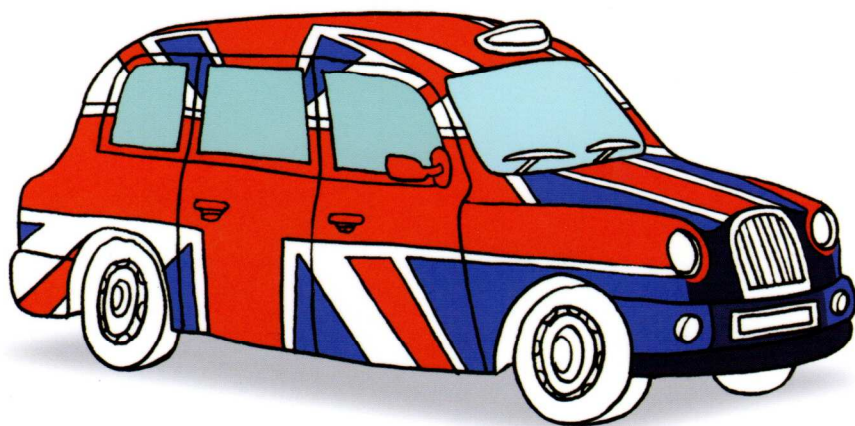
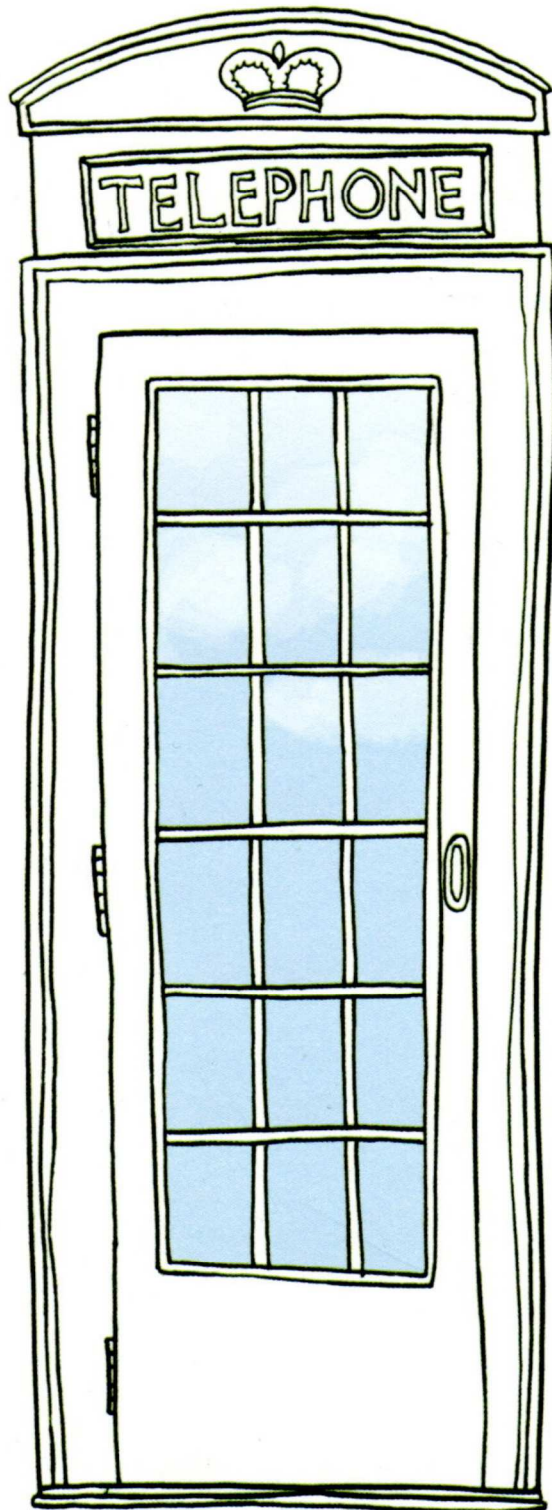


# London colouring book





There used to be bright red telephone boxes all over London. You can still see some today.

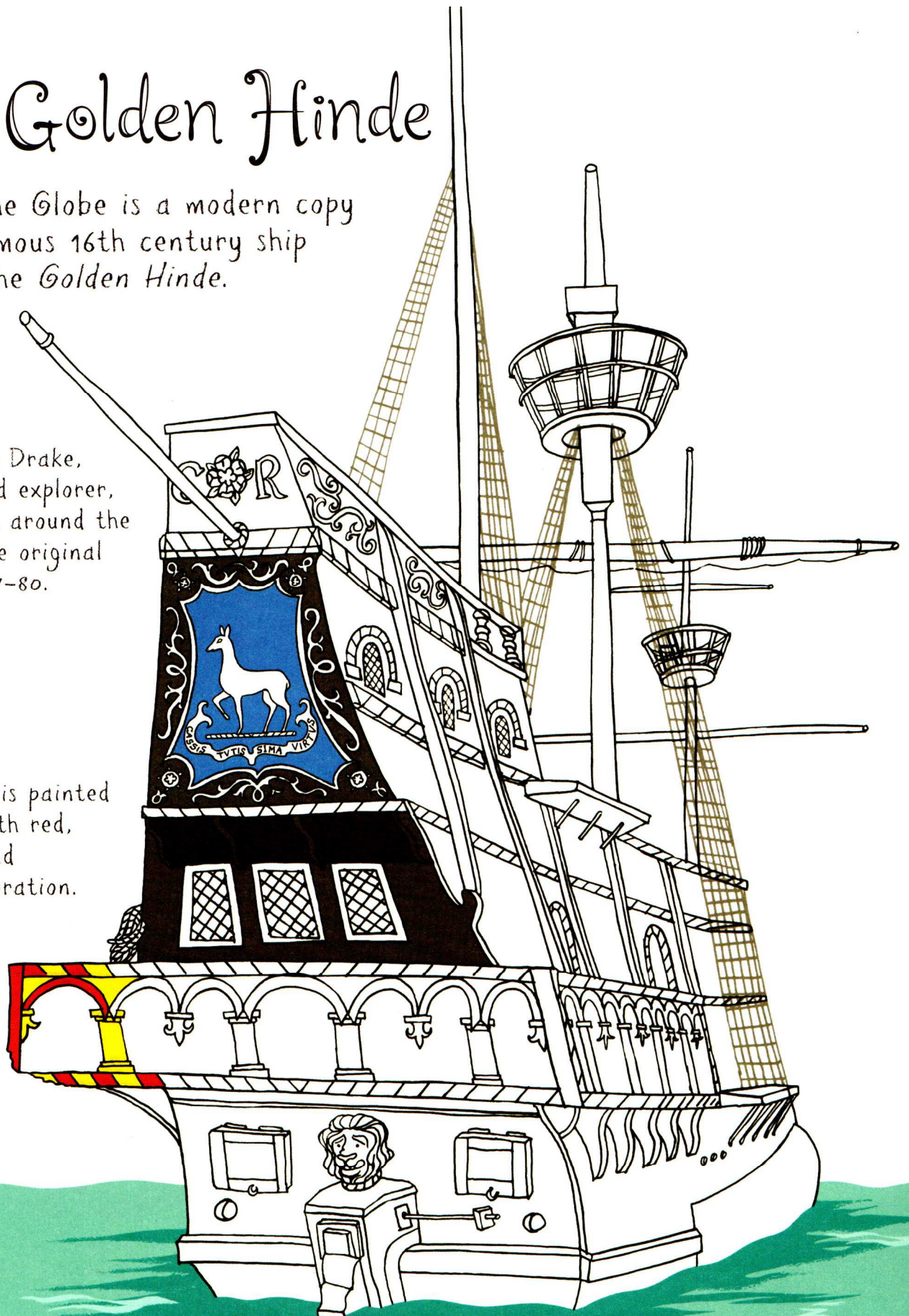


# The Golden Hinde

blue decoration.



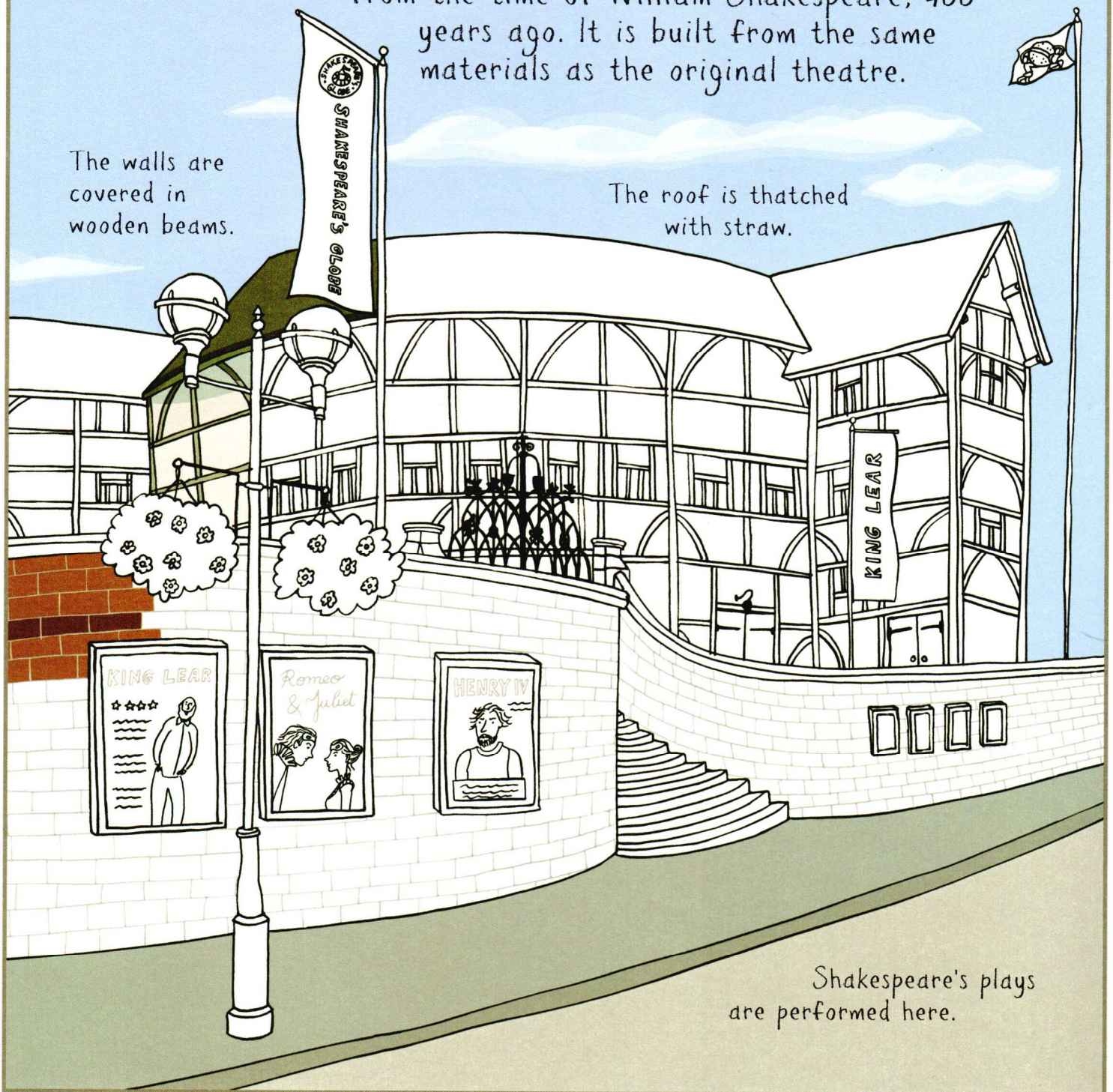


# The Globe Theatre

The roof is thatched with straw.



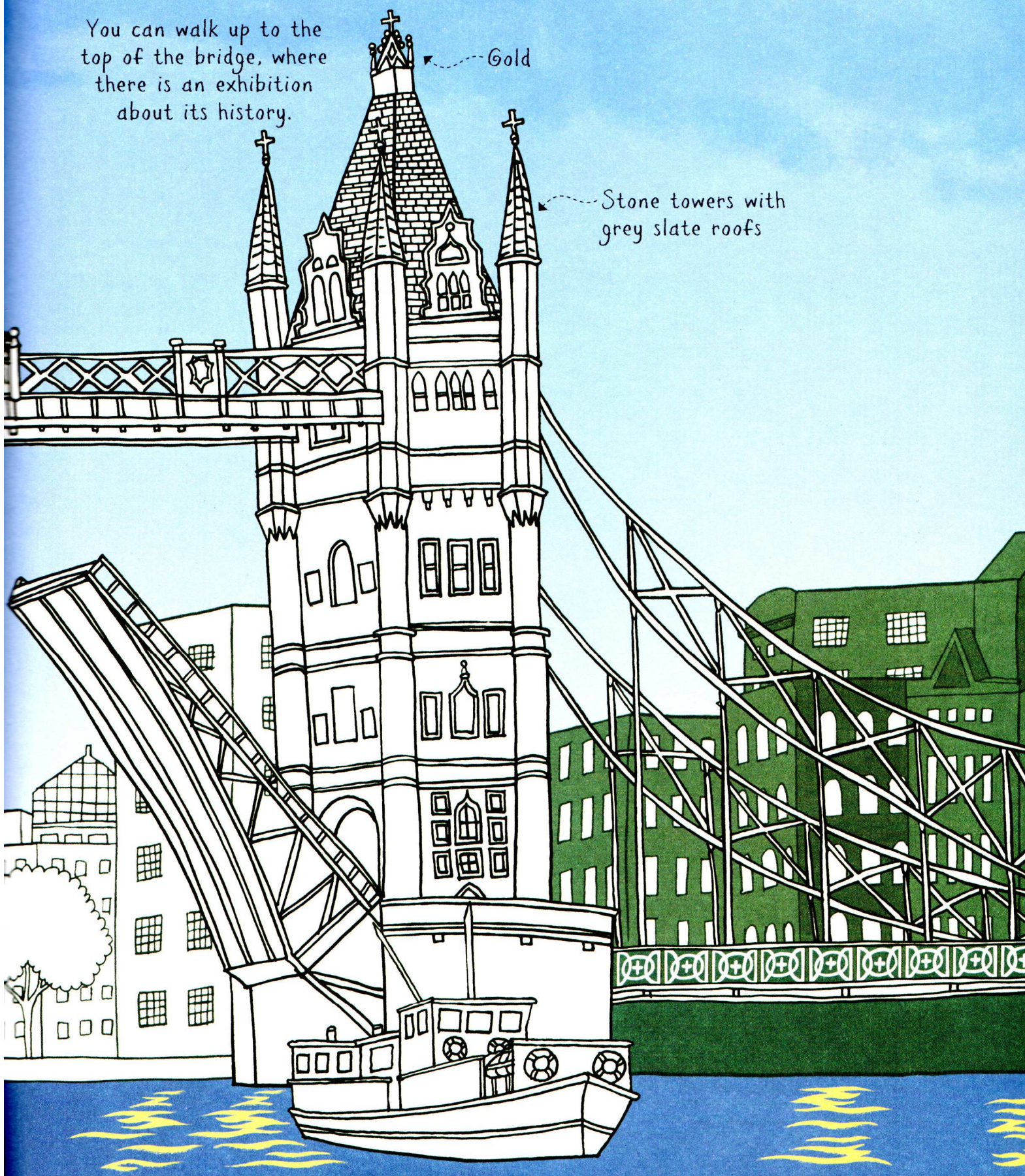
Shakespeare's plays are performed here.

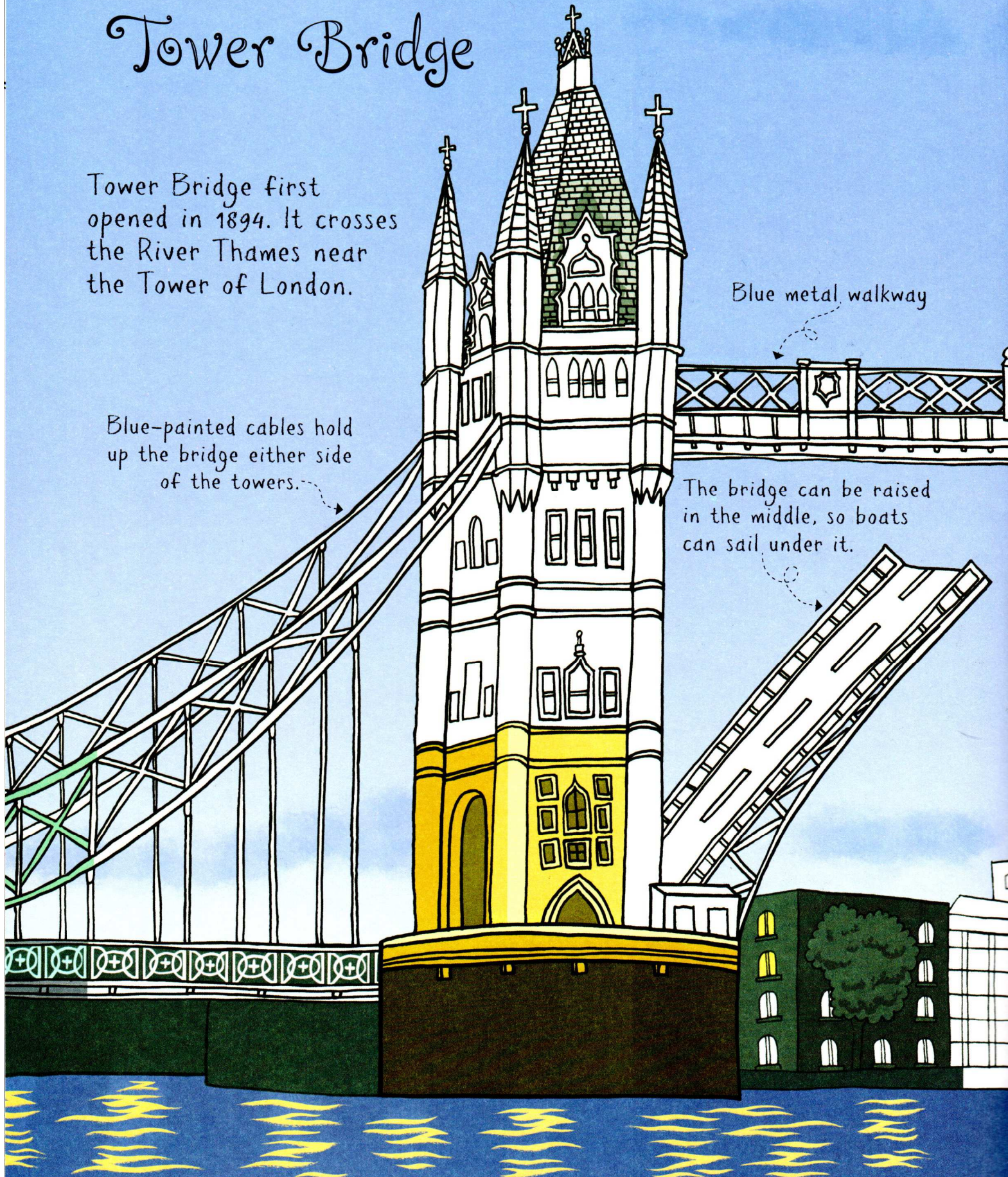
# Tower Bridge

Tower Bridge first opened in 1894. It crosses the River Thames near the Tower of London.

The bridge can be raised in the middle, so boats can sail under it.



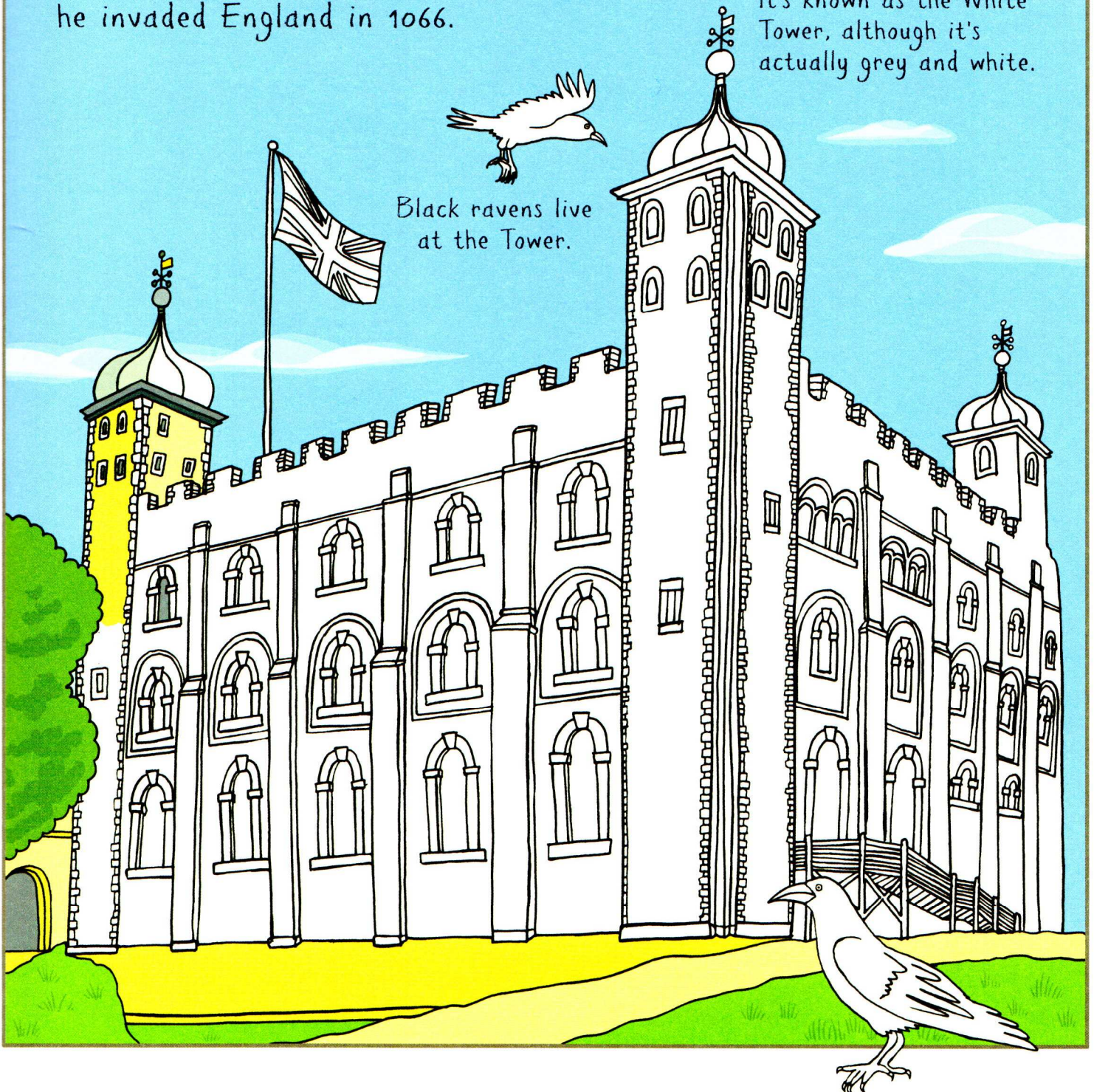


# Tower of London

This is the main building. It's known as the White Tower, although it's actually grey and white.

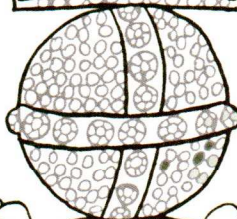
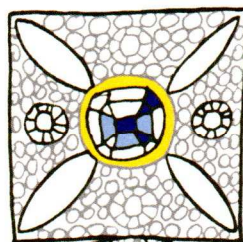
Black ravens live at the Tower.



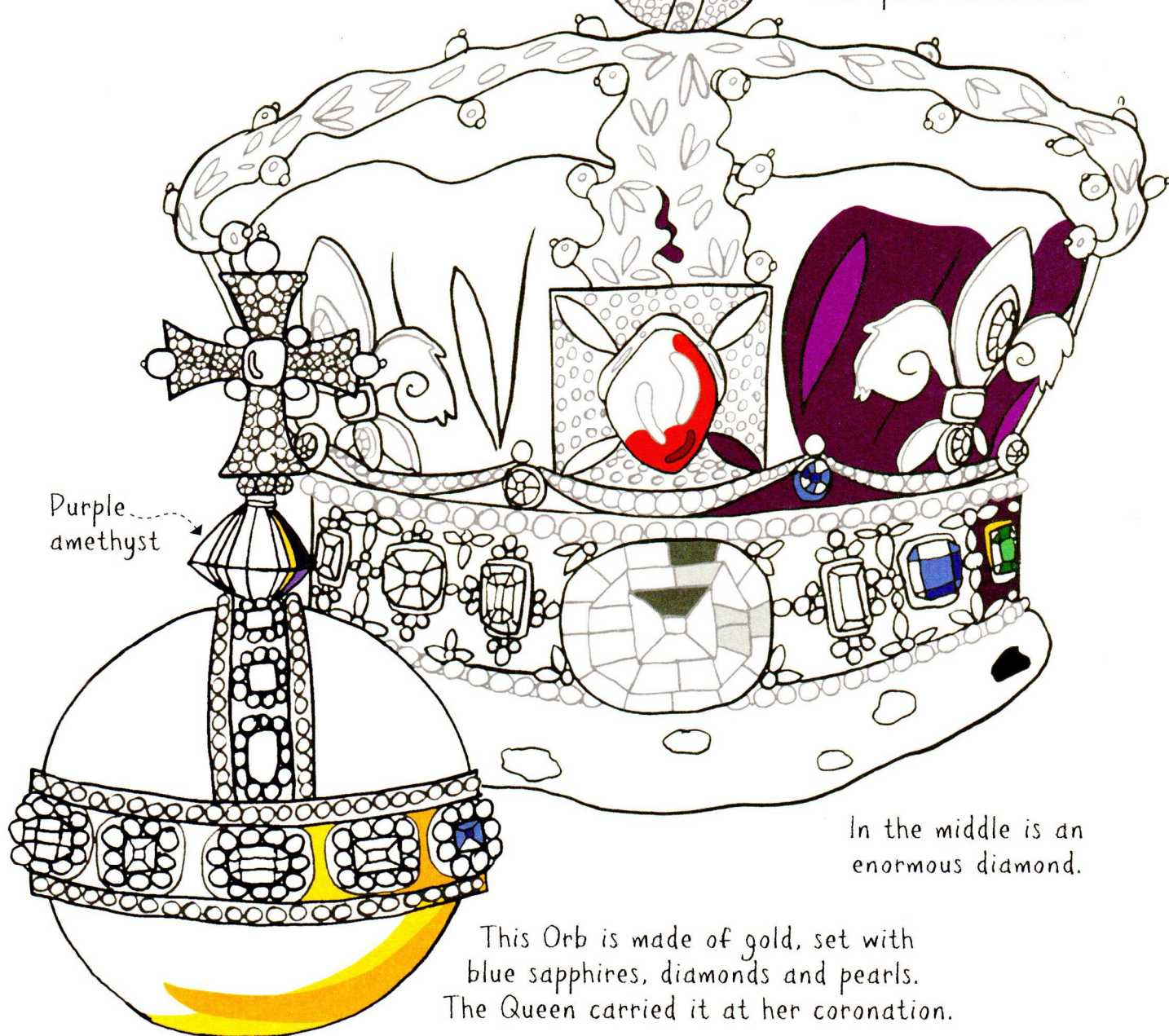


# Crown Jewels

The Imperial State Crown is set with over 3,000 precious stones. The Queen wears it when she opens Parliament.

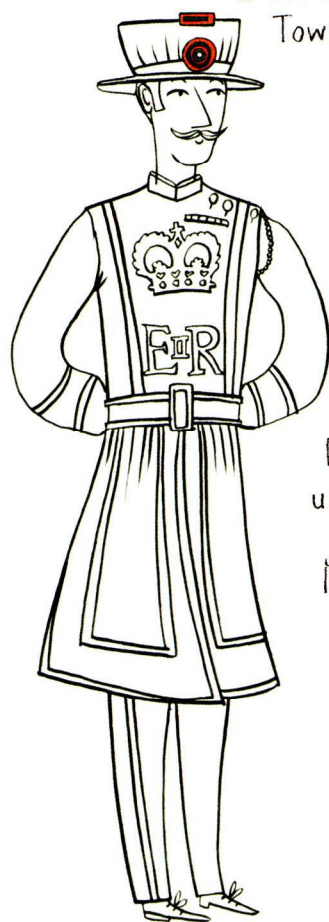


In the middle is an enormous diamond.

This Orb is made of gold, set with blue sapphires, diamonds and pearls. The Queen carried it at her coronation.

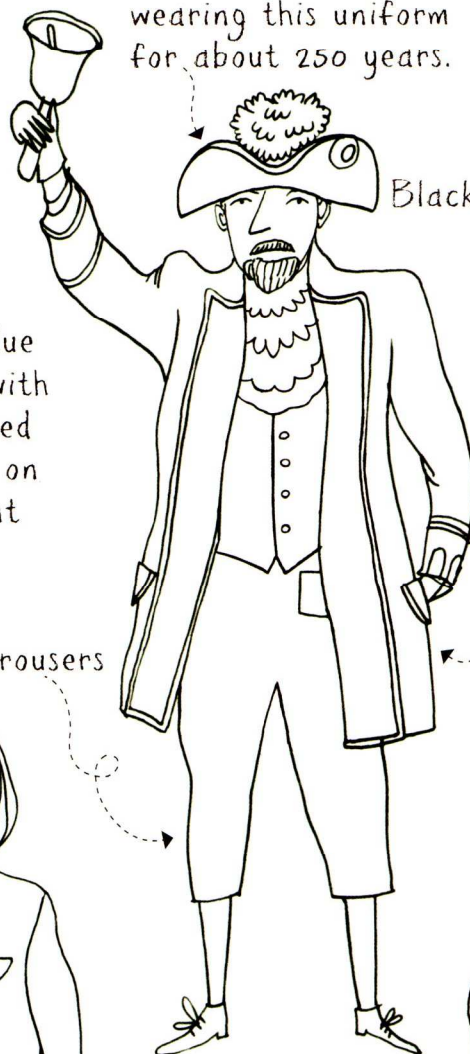


Beefeaters guard the Tower of London.

Town criers have been wearing this uniform for about 250 years.



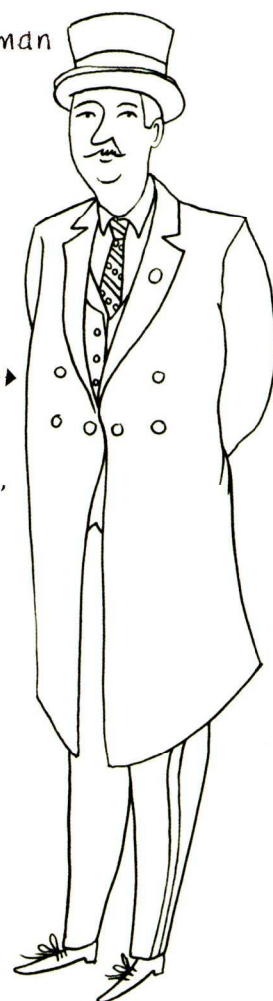

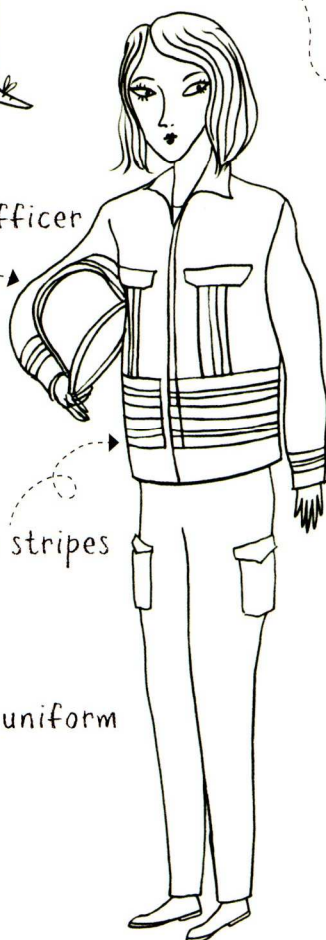

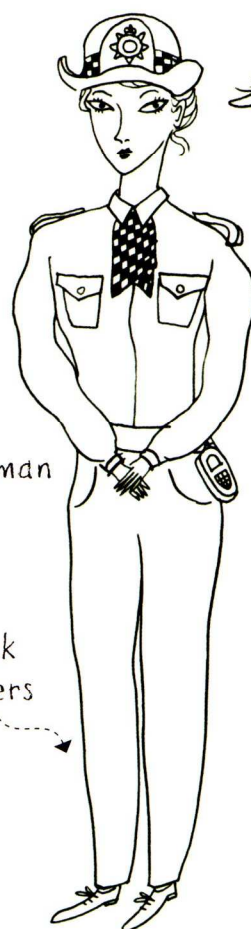
